Statement of Purpose

About the Class

In addition to what is read in class, students will independently read books of their choosing.

Late Work

Late work will be accepted up to two days. Students may receive 75% of their grade one day past the due date and 50% of their grade two days past the due date. Late work beyond two days late will not be accepted and will be recorded as a zero.

Grading

All points will be averaged. Point value will vary from assignment to assignment.

Behavior Policy

Students will be given two verbal warnings for minor infractions. After that, students will receive a lunch-detention. More serious offenses may result in an automatic lunch-detention or after school-detention, depending on the severity. If a student receives an after school-detention, it will be served the following day and a parent/guardian must sign a detention slip.

Make Up Work

If a student is absent from school, it is their responsibility to pick up make up work from the appropriate folder and complete it. Students will have two days for each day missed to complete the work.

Hall Passes

Students will be given three hall passes per semester. Students should use their passing periods wisely to save these passes for emergencies. Exits used beyond three will result in a lunch detention.

Tardies

After three tardies, students will receive an after-school detention. Tardies will start over each quarter.
